Prologue

1 ^① I wrote the first **narrative**, **Theophilus**, about all that Jesus began to do and teach ^② until the day he was taken up, after he had given instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen. ^③ After he had **suffered**, he also presented himself alive to them by many **convincing proofs**, **appearing** to them over a **period** of forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God.

The Holy Spirit Promised

^④ While he was with them, he commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to **wait** for the **Father's** promise. "Which," he said, "you have heard me speak about; ^⑤ for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit in a **few** days."

^⑥ So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, are you **restoring** the kingdom to Israel at this time?"

^⑦ He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or **periods** that the Father has set by his own **authority**. ^⑧ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the **end** of the earth."

Quote Acts 2:24, about what was not possible for death

- ▶ **God raised him up, ending the pains of death,**
- ▶ **because it was not possible for him to be held by death.**

Quote Acts 2:36, about what God had made Jesus

- ▶ **"Therefore let all the house of Israel know with certainty**
- ▶ **that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified,**
- ▶ **both Lord and Messiah."**

Quote Acts 2:38, the answer to the question, "Brothers, what should we do?"

- ▶ **Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, each of you,**
- ▶ **in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins,**
- ▶ **and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.**

Quote Acts 2:39, about who the promise is for

- ▶ **For the promise is for you and for your children,**
- ▶ **and for all who are far off,**
- ▶ **as many as the Lord our God will call."**

Quote Acts 2:42, about what they devoted themselves to

- ▶ **They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching,**
- ▶ **to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer.**
